7 Section 1. This act shall be cited as the "Stop the Nanny
 8 State, Big Government, and Abolition of Individual Choice Act."

9 Section 2. Any county or municipality that enacts an
 10 ordinance regulating smoking on public beaches or in public
 11 parks is subject to a \$10 million fine payable to Cigar Rights
 12 of America for each ordinance enacted.

13 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.

19 An act relating to the regulation of smoking by
20 counties and municipalities; providing a short title;
21 providing that any county or municipality that enacts
22 an ordinance regulating smoking on public beaches or
23 in public parks is subject to a fine for each such
24 ordinance enacted; providing an effective date.

37 WHEREAS, the history of cigar rolling is intertwined and
38 synonymous with the state's immigrant story, and

39 WHEREAS, any law limiting or deterring cigar smoking is
40 abhorrent to Floridians and must not be allowed, NOW, THEREFORE,
