- (2) The department shall establish an application process for eligible individuals and criteria for, at a minimum, the determination of significant financial need. Scholarships shall be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis subject to available funding.
- (3) To be eligible for a scholarship under this program, an individual must:
- (a) Have been a resident for tuition purposes pursuant to s. 1009.21 during his or her postsecondary education.
- (b) Have been a recipient of a state-funded scholarship or grant award under chapter 1009 for at least one year of his or her postsecondary education.
- (c) Have a significant financial need as determined pursuant to subsection (2).
- (d) Have graduated from a postsecondary education institution in this state with at least a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale in the last 2 years.
- (4) Scholarships shall be awarded to individuals for a period of 2 years as follows:
- (a) For the first year, each individual shall receive \$400 per month.
- (b) For the second year, each individual shall receive \$300 per month.
