Remove lines 47-58 and insert:

7 order to assess the viability of loans, an economic development

8 agency may obtain sensitive information of an applicant or

9 borrower, including certain contact and financial information.

10 If released, the sensitive information could be used by

11 fraudulent contractors, predatory lenders, thieves, or

12 individuals seeking to impose on the applicant or borrower.

13 Therefore, it is necessary that sensitive information held by an

14 economic development agency pursuant to its administration of

15 any state or federally funded small business loan program be

16 protected to ensure that applicants and borrowers are not

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## 17 harassed, intimidated, or potentially defrauded. The Legislature

- 18 finds the harm that may result from the release of such
- 19 sensitive information outweighs the public benefit that may be
- 20 derived from the disclosure of the information.

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
