- (a)1. For labor or services of any child <u>younger than 18</u> <u>years of under the</u> age <u>or an adult believed by the person to be a child younger than of 18 years of age commits a felony of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.</u>
- 2. Using coercion for labor or services of an adult commits a felony of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
