- (b) Effective October 1, 2021, any or all of the tax collectors may contract with one or more license plate agencies for the provision of the following specified driver license services:
- 1. Processing a licensee's application for renewal of any driver license eligible for renewal using a convenience service.
- 2. Processing a licensee's application for reinstatement of a suspended driver license and collecting the required fees therefor, if the only condition of reinstatement is payment of such fees.
- 3. Processing a licensee's or cardholder's request to change his or her address and application for a replacement driver license or identification card, and collecting the required fees therefor, if the licensee or cardholder is not required to renew in person.

If a tax collector who elects to contract with a license plate agency for the provision of these services has not entered into an interagency agreement with the department under paragraph (a), the department shall, upon application, authorize the tax collector by interagency agreement, subject to the requirements of law, in accordance with rules of the department, to provide

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these services as the department's agent through one or more
license plate agencies. A tax collector's election to contract
with a license plate agency under this paragraph does not
require the tax collector to provide all driver license services
authorized under paragraph (a). This paragraph does not
authorize a license plate agency to issue driver licenses or
identification cards or possess any blank driver licenses or
identification cards. If funds to be deposited into the State
Treasury are collected under this paragraph by a license plate
agency, the funds shall be paid into the State Treasury within
the period specified in subsection (6) calculated from the date
the funds are collected by the license plate agency.

- (c) (b) Each tax collector who is authorized by the department to provide driver license services shall bear all costs associated with providing those services.
- (d) (e) A service fee of \$6.25 must be charged, in addition to the fees set forth in this chapter, for providing all services pursuant to this chapter. The service fee may not be charged:
- 1. More than once per customer during a single visit to a tax collector's office.
- 2. For a reexamination requested by the Medical Advisory Board or required pursuant to s. 322.221.
 - 3. For a voter registration transaction.
 - 4. In violation of any federal or state law.
