20	(4) AGENCY PERSONNEL INFORMATION						
21	(d)1. For purposes of this paragraph, the term:						
22	a. "Home addresses" means the dwelling location at which						
23	an individual resides and includes the physical address, mailing						
24	address, street address, parcel identification number, plot						
25	identification number, legal property description, neighborhood						
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26 name and lot number, GPS coordinates, and any other descriptive 27 property information that may reveal the home address.

b. "Telephone numbers" includes home telephone numbers, personal cellular telephone numbers, personal pager telephone numbers, and telephone numbers associated with personal communications devices.

The written request must be notarized and must 294 specify the information to be released and the party that is 295 authorized to receive the information. Upon receipt of the 296 written request, the custodial agency shall release the 297 specified information to the party authorized to receive such information. 298

5. The exemptions in this paragraph apply to information held by an agency before, on, or after the effective date of the

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301 exemption.

302 6. This paragraph is subject to the Open Government Sunset
303 Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repealed
304 on October 2, 2024, unless reviewed and saved from repeal
305 through reenactment by the Legislature.

306 Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public 307 necessity that the home addresses, telephone numbers, places of 308 employment, dates of birth, and photographs of current or former 309 staff and domestic violence advocates of domestic violence centers certified by the Department of Children and Families 310 311 under chapter 39; the names, home addresses, telephone numbers, 312 places of employment, dates of birth, and photographs of the 313 spouses and children of such personnel; and the names and 314 locations of schools and day care facilities attended by the 315 children of such personnel be exempt from public records 316 requirements. Such personnel and their family members are at a 317 heightened risk of physical and emotional harm from perpetrators 318 of domestic violence who have contentious reactions to actions 319 taken by such personnel to house and protect victims of domestic 320 violence and limit further harm to such victims. The Legislature 321 further finds that it is necessary to provide safeguards to 322 staff and domestic violence advocates who are offering their time to protect victims of domestic violence. Without such 323 protection, individuals may be less willing to volunteer or work 324 325 for such centers, thus reducing the pool of resources and
