20	report by December 31, 2021, that includes information and
21	updates regarding the implementation of recommendations from the
22	Little Wekiva River Watershed Management Plan Final Report dated
23	November 2005. The report shall include, but not be limited to,
24	the following information: a description of all projects or
25	recommendations included in the report that have been

26	implemented and the completion dates, an analysis of how the
27	projects or recommendations achieved the results included in the
28	report, an analysis of costs for ongoing operation and
29	maintenance of completed construction projects, an analysis of
30	any new projects that may benefit the watershed, and
31	recommendations and cost estimates for future studies or
32	projects that may be necessary to identify new or potentially
33	significant contributors of sediment accumulation in the Little
34	Wekiva River. Appropriate action to resolve compliance issues
35	shall be taken pursuant to chapter 373, Florida Statutes, if the
36	Department of Environmental Protection or the water management
37	district discovers a violation of any permit condition.
38	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.
