An act relating to bicycle operation regulations; amending s. 316.2065, F.S.; providing an exception to the requirement that a person operating a bicycle ride upon or astride a seat attached thereto; amending s. 316.20655, F.S.; revising construction relating to electric bicycle regulations; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 316.2065, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

316.2065 Bicycle regulations.-

(2) A person operating a bicycle may not ride other than upon or astride a permanent and regular seat attached thereto unless the bicycle was designed by the manufacturer to be ridden without a seat.

Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 316.20655, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

316.20655 Electric bicycle regulations.-

(1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, an electric bicycle or an operator of an electric bicycle shall be afforded all the rights and privileges, and be subject to all of the duties, of a bicycle or the operator of a bicycle, including s. 316.2065. An electric bicycle is a vehicle to the same extent as a bicycle. However, this section may not be construed to prevent a local government, through the exercise of its powers under s. 316.008, from adopting an ordinance governing the
