Appropriations Subcommittee on Criminal and Civil Justice
(Brandes) recommended the following:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Delete lines 130 - 137

and insert:

Effective July 1, 2030, and every 10 years thereafter, the
\$50,000 jurisdictional limit in subparagraph 3. must be adjusted
and increased by the percentage change in the Consumer Price
Index for All Urban Consumers, U.S. City Average, All Items
1982-84=100, or successor reports, for the preceding 10 calendar
years as initially reported by the United States Department of

11 Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics. The adjusted jurisdictional
12 limit must be rounded to the nearest \$5,000. However, the
13 jurisdictional limit may not be lower than \$50,000. The Office
14 of Economic and Demographic Research must calculate the adjusted
15 jurisdictional limit and certify the adjusted jurisdictional
16 limit to the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court beginning
17 January 31, 2030, and every 10 years thereafter. The Office of
18 Economic and Demographic Research and the Office of the State
19 Courts Administrator must publish the adjusted jurisdictional
20 limit on their websites.
