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House Resolution

A resolution designating April 16, 2021, as Wolf-Hirschhorn/4p- Syndrome Awareness Day.

5 WHEREAS, the health and well-being of all Floridians is of 6 the utmost importance to the prosperity and livelihood of our 7 state's families and communities, and

8 WHEREAS, Wolf-Hirschhorn syndrome, also known as 4p-9 syndrome, is a chromosomal disorder caused by a partial deletion 10 of the short arm of chromosome 4, and

11 WHEREAS, children with 4p- syndrome are usually born with 12 low birth weight and develop slowly, both cognitively and 13 physically, compared to their same-age peers, and experience 14 medical complications while still trying to maintain a normal 15 childhood, and

WHEREAS, dedicated professionals in the medical field are presently involved in valuable research on this extremely rare disease, its misdiagnosis, and the exploration of new therapies and diagnostic tools to offer hope to individuals with 4psyndrome and their families, and

21 WHEREAS, the National Institutes of Health estimates that 1 22 in 50,000 births result in 4p- syndrome, which may be an 23 underestimate because some affected individuals may go 24 undiagnosed, and

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25	WHEREAS, effective diagnostic screenings, early
26	intervention, treatments, and families and advocates play a
27	vital role in helping advance the knowledge and awareness of 4p-
28	syndrome, and
29	WHEREAS, doctors in Florida currently provide services to
30	diagnose, treat, and study Wolf-Hirschhorn/4p- Syndrome, NOW,
