8	WHEREAS, Myalgic encephalomyelitis (ME), also known as
9	chronic fatigue syndrome (CFS) or (ME/CFS), is a neuroimmune
10	disease characterized by overwhelming fatigue, neurological
11	impairment, pain, postexertional malaise, headaches, cardiac
12	symptoms, immune dysfunction, hypometabolism, lack of energy
13	production at a cellular level, orthostatic intolerance, severe
14	dizziness and balance problems, increased morbidity, and a
15	higher risk of suicide due to a lack of study within the medical
16	community which has resulted in a lack of available treatments,
17	and

18 WHEREAS, ME/CFS has been found by the National Academy of 19 Medicine (NAM) to be "a serious, chronic, complex, and systemic 20 disease that frequently and dramatically limits the activities 21 of affected patients" producing a lower quality of life than 22 multiple sclerosis, stroke, renal failure, heart failure, and 23 other chronic diseases, and

24 WHEREAS, there are an estimated 17 million patients 25 afflicted with ME/CFS worldwide, with 836,000 to 2.5 million

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26 patients in the United States and a number of reported cases in 27 Florida, and

28 WHEREAS, ME/CFS is predominantly a postinfectious disease, 29 with nearly 75 percent of patients developing chronic disease 30 following acute infections, and

31 WHEREAS, coronaviruses and other viral pathogens can 32 trigger ME/CFS and experts are estimating significant surges in 33 ME/CFS cases following the COVID-19 pandemic, and

34 WHEREAS, ME/CFS persists for years or a lifetime, leaving 35 many patients housebound or bedbound, with the most severely 36 affected unable to speak, eat, or process sound or light, and 37 most unable to attend school or work, and

38 WHEREAS, NAM noted that the medical community "generally 39 still doubts the existence or seriousness of this disease" and 40 patients have difficulty getting diagnosed or accessing quality 41 medical care, given only a dozen United States clinical research 42 facilities serve 1 million to 2.5 million ME/CFS patients, and

WHEREAS, there is still no treatment approved by the United
States Food and Drug Administration for ME/CFS and almost no
treatment trials, NOW, THEREFORE,

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47 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of 48 Florida:

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50 That May 2021 is designated as "Myalgic Encephalomyelitis/ 51 Chronic Fatigue Syndrome Awareness Month" and May 12, 2021, is 52 designated as "Myalgic Encephalomyelitis/Chronic Fatigue 53 Syndrome Awareness Day" in Florida to spread awareness of the 54 disease.
