- (b) Tuition and fees charged to a student who is granted an out-of-state fee waiver under this subsection may not exceed the tuition and fees charged to a resident student. The waiver is applicable for 110 percent of the required credit hours of the degree or certificate program for which the student is enrolled.
- (c) Each Florida College System institution, career center operated by a school district under s. 1001.44, and charter technical career center under s. 1002.34 shall report to the State Board of Education the number and value of all fee waivers granted annually under this subsection.
- (d) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules to administer this subsection.
