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serve:

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20	(a) A public utility of an electric utility as defined in
27	this chapter;
28	(b) An entity formed under s. 163.01 that generates,
29	sells, or transmits electrical energy;
30	(c) A natural gas utility as defined in s. 366.04(3)(c);

37	(2) Notwithstanding the restrictions of this section, this

12	(3) This section does not expand or alter the jurisdiction
43	of the commission over public utilities or electric utilities.
44	Section 2. Any municipality, county, special district, or
45	political subdivision charter, resolution, ordinance, rule,
46	code, policy, or action that is preempted by this act that
47	existed before or on July 1, 2021, is void.
48	Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2021.

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
