Between lines 1181 and 1182, insert:

Section 32. Section 551.118, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

551.118 Compulsive and ~~or~~ addictive gambling prevention program.—

(1) Each slot machine licensee, as defined in s. 551.104, shall participate in a compulsive and addictive gambling prevention program approved by the Florida Gaming Control Commission. Each ~~The~~ slot machine licensee shall:

(a) Provide responsible gaming awareness ~~offer~~ training to employees for the purpose of recognizing compulsive and

18 with a compulsive and ~~or~~ addictive gambling prevention program
19 administered by the commission to further the intent of this
20 section to recognize problem gaming situations and to implement

22 (b)(2) Display adequate signage in all public access areas
23 of the licensee's facilities, that display words similar or
24 comparable to, "if you or someone you know has a gambling
25 problem and wants help, call (888)-ADMIT-IT."

26 (c) Display the words, "gambling problem" and "call (888)-
27 ADMIT-IT" on all print, billboard, sign, online, or broadcast
28 advertisements of a sports betting or fantasy sports contest, or
29 other type of covered games offered online or via mobile or
30 other electronic devices, or in a sports wagering room. The
31 division shall, subject to competitive bidding, contract for
32 provision of services related to the prevention of compulsive
33 and addictive gambling. The contract shall provide for an
34 advertising program to encourage responsible gaming practices
35 and to publicize a gambling telephone help line. Such
36 advertisements must be made both publicly and inside the
37 designated slot machine gaming areas of the licensee's
38 facilities. The terms of any contract for the provision of such
39 services shall include accountability standards that must be met
40 by any private provider. The failure of any private provider to
41 meet any material terms of the contract, including the

48 (2)(3) For the purpose of funding a compulsive and ~~or~~
49 addictive gambling prevention program pursuant to s. 550.135,
50 the commission shall collect from each slot machine licensee, an
51 annual fee of .003 percent of each licensee's gross revenues
52 collected pursuant to s. 550.135(4) ~~shall be funded from an~~
53 annual nonrefundable regulatory fee of \$250,000 paid by the
54 licensee to the division.
