Section 3. Section 448.077, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

448.077 Retaliation due to quarantine related to COVID-19 prohibited.-An employer may not terminate, demote, or retaliate against an employee who has tested positive for COVID-19 as evidenced by a valid laboratory test or who in good faith believes he or she was exposed or may have been exposed to
