Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Between lines 265 and 266

insert:

(8) This section may not be construed to prohibit an employer from offering an incentive to employees for voluntarily receiving a COVID-19 vaccination.

(9) An employer must grant an employee up to 3 weeks of paid leave if the employee is exposed to or contracts COVID-19 or if the employee's immediate family member is exposed or to or contracts COVID-19.
