Section 4. Effective October 1, 2022, section 960.0023, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

960.0023 Duty of candor to an alleged victim.—A person who has been arrested or charged with a crime or a delinquent act, as well as the person's attorney or agent, who contacts the alleged victim to obtain information relating to the alleged victim or the crime or delinquent act may not misrepresent his

12 or her identity or the identity of the person he or she is  
13 representing or on whose behalf he or she is working. A person  
14 who violates this section commits a misdemeanor of the second  
15 degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
