4 Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

5 Section 1. Section 582.195, Florida Statutes, is created
6 to read:

7 582.195 Mandatory meeting of supervisors.-All five
8 supervisors of the governing body of each district must meet at
9 least once per calendar year in a public meeting pursuant to s.
10 286.011.

11 Section 2. Section 582.295, Florida Statutes, is created
12 to read:

13 582.295 Automatic dissolution of districts.-

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14 (1) If the governing body of a district fails to meet as
15 required under s. 582.195, the district shall be automatically
16 dissolved as of January 1 of the year immediately following the
17 year in which the governing body failed to meet. All assets and
18 liabilities of the district shall be transferred to the
19 Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.

20 (2) Sections 189.076, 582.30, 582.31, and 582.32 do not
21 apply to dissolution of a district under this section.

22 Section 3. The Department of Economic Opportunity declared
23 the Baker Soil and Water Conservation District inactive on
24 August 3, 2020, and the Martin Soil and Water Conservation
25 District inactive on March 17, 2020, therefore, the districts
26 are hereby dissolved and all assets and liabilities of the
27 districts are transferred to the Department of Agriculture and
28 Consumer Services.

29 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
