A bill to be entitled

An act relating to surplus lines tax on flood insurance premiums; amending s. 626.932, F.S.; providing that premiums charged for surplus lines coverages for the peril of flood are not subject to a specified premium receipts tax; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 626.932, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

626.932 Surplus lines tax.-

(1) (a) Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (b), the premiums charged for surplus lines coverages are subject to a premium receipts tax of 4.94 percent of all gross premiums charged for such insurance. The surplus lines agent shall collect from the insured the amount of the tax at the time of the delivery of the cover note, certificate of insurance, policy, or other initial confirmation of insurance, in addition to the full amount of the gross premium charged by the insurer for the insurance. The surplus lines agent is prohibited from absorbing such tax or, as an inducement for insurance or for any other reason, rebating all or any part of such tax or of his or her commission.
