Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 322.20, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

322.20 Records of the department; fees; destruction of records.-

(3) The department shall maintain convenient records or make suitable notations, in order that the individual driver history record of each licensee is readily available for the consideration of the department upon application for renewal of a license and at other suitable times.

- (a) The release by the department of the driver history record, with respect to crashes involving a licensee, shall not include any notation or record of the occurrence of a motor vehicle crash unless the licensee received a traffic citation as a direct result of the crash, and to this extent such notation or record is exempt from the provisions of s. 119.07(1).
- (b) The release by the department of the driver history record to a third party shall not include any notation or record of a uniform traffic citation or an election made under s. 318.14(9) for the citation if, pursuant to the department's records retention schedule, the citation would otherwise have

been excluded from the driver history record if the election
under s. 318.14(9) was not made.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
