24	Prevention Training Pilot Program. The purpose of the pilot

27	training and certification in the prevention of veteran suicide.
28	(2) Persons who choose to participate in the pilot program
29	must be trained to identify indicators of elevated suicide risk

31	expressing or exhibiting symptoms of emotional or psychological
32	distress. The department shall contract with an organization
33	with proven experience in developing and implementing veteran-
34	relevant, evidence-based suicide prevention training to develop
35	the curriculum for training under the pilot program. The

37	administering such training and certifying those participants
38	who successfully complete such training.
39	(3) Pursuant to its rulemaking authority under s.

43	of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by
44	June 30 of each year which includes information concerning the
45	pilot program and whether any changes should be made to the
46	pilot program which would increase its effectiveness. In its
47	report submitted by June 30, 2026, the department shall include
48	a recommendation of whether the pilot program should be
