 11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 13 Section 1. Prohibiting cooperation with a United States
 14 Capitol Police office located in the state.—

15 (1) A state or local law enforcement agency or other state
 16 or local agency may not use agency resources or personnel to
 17 cooperate with or assist any activities or personnel of a field
 18 office or branch office of the United States Capitol Police
 19 located in the state.

20 (2) A state or local law enforcement agency or other state
 21 or local agency may not:

22 (a) Make available an agency database for purposes of
 23 cooperation with or assistance to a field office or branch
 24 office of the United States Capitol Police or its personnel
 25 located in the state. Any agreement to make available a database

26 | in conflict with this subsection which is in existence on the
27 | effective date of this act is invalid.

28 | (b) Recognize the jurisdiction of the United States
29 | Capitol Police or its personnel.

30 | (3) This section does not prevent a state or local agency
31 | from responding to a court order.

32 | (4) This section supersedes any conflicting policy, rule,
33 | procedure, or practice within the state.

34 | Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
