Section 3. The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity that, in a trust proceeding involving a trust regulated under chapters 662 or 736, inventories of the trust's assets and any accountings be made confidential and exempt from s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. Public disclosure of such inventories and accountings, which relate to a trust's assets and may contain sensitive financial information, in these trust proceedings can result in specific harm to beneficiaries and other interested parties, as such persons or parties could be targeted for fraud, exploitation, or abuse. Therefore, the Legislature finds that the need to protect the inventories and accountings in a trust proceeding involving a trust regulated under chapters 662 or 736 is sufficiently compelling to override the state's public policy of open government and that the protection of such information cannot be accomplished without this exemption.

Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
