Remove lines 30-38 and insert:

(a) If the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has not 7 finalized its own standards for PFAS in drinking water, 8 groundwater, or soil by January 1, 2025, the department shall 9 adopt by rule statewide cleanup levels for PFAS in drinking water, groundwater, and soil using criteria set forth in s. 376.30701, with priority given to PFOA and PFOS. The rules for statewide cleanup target levels may not take effect until ratified by the Legislature. (b) Until the department's rule for a particular PFAS 15 constituent has been ratified by the Legislature, a governmental entity or private water supplier may not be subject to any 16 614763 - h1475.line30.docx
