6 (a) If the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has not
 7 finalized its own standards for PFAS in drinking water,
 8 groundwater, and soil by January 1, 2025, the department shall
 9 adopt by rule statewide cleanup levels for PFAS in drinking
 10 water, groundwater, and soil using criteria set forth in s.
 11 376.30701, with priority given to PFOA and PFOS. The rules for
 12 statewide cleanup target levels may not take effect until
 13 ratified by the Legislature.

14 (b) Until the department's rule for a particular PFAS
 15 constituent has been ratified by the Legislature, a governmental
 16 entity or private water supplier may not be subject to any
