A bill to be entitled

An act relating to membership organization health coverage; creating s. 624.4032, F.S.; providing a short title; providing a purpose; defining the terms "farm bureau" and "not-for-profit membership organization"; providing that health coverage provided by certain entities is not insurance; authorizing risks under such coverage to be reinsured; requiring entities providing such coverage to annually file a certain statement; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Section 624.4032, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

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624.4032 Farm bureau and not-for-profit membership health coverage.-

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(1) This act may be cited as the "Farm Bureau and Not-For-Profit Membership Health Coverage Act of 2021."

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(2) The purpose of this act is to allow not-for-profit membership organizations to offer new health coverage options to their members.

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(3) For purposes of this section, the term:

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(a) "Farm bureau" means a not-for-profit agricultural membership organization incorporated in this state, or an affiliate, designated as the state's farm bureau.

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(b) "Not-for-profit membership organization" means a professional or trade association or any entity with dues-paying members which is exempt from federal income tax under section

501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code and exists to serve its members beyond only offering health coverage.

- (4) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the health coverage provided by a farm bureau, a not-for-profit membership organization, or an agricultural cooperative association created under chapter 618 or chapter 619 is not insurance for purposes of the Florida Insurance Code.
- (5) The risk under health coverage provided pursuant to this section may be reinsured by a company authorized to transact reinsurance in this state.
- (6) A farm bureau, a not-for-profit membership organization, or an agricultural cooperative association providing health coverage pursuant to this section shall annually file with the office a signed, certified actuarial statement of plan reserves.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2023.
