Section 1. Subsection (119) is added to section 320.08058, Florida Statutes, to read:

320.08058 Specialty license plates.

(119) SAFE HAVEN FOR NEWBORNS LICENSE PLATES.-

(a) The department shall develop a Safe Haven for Newborns license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The plate must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "A Safe Haven for Newborns" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

(b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall be distributed to the Gloria M. Silverio Foundation, Incorporated, a nonprofit Florida corporation under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, the mission of which is to prevent infant abandonment through awareness, education, and direct assistance. Up to 10 percent of the fees may be used for marketing of the plate and costs directly associated with administration of the foundation. The remaining funds shall be used by the foundation to prevent infant abandonment through awareness, education, and
