11	Section 1. Subsection (119) is added to section 320.08058,

15	(a) The department shall develop a Down Syndrome Awareness
16	license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The
17	plate must bear the colors and design approved by the
18	department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
19	plate, and the words "Down Syndrome Awareness" must appear at
20	the bottom of the plate.
21	(b) The annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall
22	be distributed to Our City Beautiful, Inc., a Florida nonprofit
23	corporation. Up to 10 percent of the fees may be used for
24	administrative costs and marketing of the plate. Of the

27	HOLLAND, an affordable housing project for independent living

32	years of age or older with Down Syndrome who wish to further
33	their education at postsecondary educational institutions
