26 person, the birth month of the person whose name first appears 27 on the registration shall be used to determine the registration 28 period. For a vehicle subject to this registration period, the 29 renewal period is the 30-day period ending at midnight on the 30 vehicle owner's date of birth.

(2) For a vehicle subject to registration under s.
32 320.08(11) and not owned by a natural person, the registration
33 period begins January 1 and ends December 31. For a vehicle
34 subject to this registration period, the renewal period is the
35 31-day period before prior to expiration.

Beginning September 1, 2023, in order to 36 Section 2. 37 implement the amendment made by this act to s. 320.055, Florida Statutes, the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles 38 39 shall give customers the option to renew their registrations on 40 their dates of birth in 2024 or 2025. Customers whose dates of 41 birth occur in the months of January through June may choose to 42 renew for 1 to 18 months. Customers whose dates of birth occur 43 in the months of July through December may choose to renew for 7 44 to 24 months. 45 Section 3. This act shall take effect September 1, 2023.
