(5) At the time of qualifying for office, each candidate for a constitutional office <u>and each candidate for other</u> <u>elective office subject to an annual filing requirement under s.</u> <u>112.3144,</u> shall file a full and public disclosure of financial interests pursuant to s. 8, Art. II of the State Constitution,
