(1) (a) The Department of Health, in collaboration with the Board of Medicine, shall conduct a study evaluating the therapeutic efficacy of alternative therapies, including the use of 3,4-methylenedioxymethamphetamine, psilocybin, and ketamine, in treating mental health and other medical conditions, including all of the following:

- 1. Depression.
 - 2. Anxiety.
 - 3. Posttraumatic stress disorder.
- 4. Bipolar disorder.
 - 5. Chronic pain.
 - 6. Migraines.
 - (b) In conducting the study, the department shall:
 - 1. Evaluate and determine whether alternative therapies are
