Between lines 90 and 91, insert:

(s) The construction, installation, operation, or maintenance of floating vessel platforms or floating boat lifts, provided that such structures:

10 1. Float at all times in the water for the sole purpose of 11 supporting a vessel so that the vessel is out of the water when 12 not in use;

13 2. Are wholly contained within a boat slip previously 14 permitted under ss. 403.91-403.929, 1984 Supplement to the 15 Florida Statutes 1983, as amended, or part IV of chapter 373, or 16 do not exceed a combined total of 500 square feet, or 200 square 016873 - h0349-line90.docx

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17 feet in an Outstanding Florida Water, when associated with a 18 dock that is exempt under this subsection or associated with a 19 permitted dock with no defined boat slip or attached to a 20 bulkhead on a parcel of land where there is no other docking 21 structure;

3. Are not used for any commercial purpose or for mooring vessels that remain in the water when not in use, and do not substantially impede the flow of water, create a navigational hazard, or unreasonably infringe upon the riparian rights of adjacent property owners, as defined in s. 253.141;

4. Are constructed and used so as to minimize adverse
impacts to submerged lands, wetlands, shellfish areas, aquatic
plant and animal species, and other biological communities,
including locating such structures in areas where seagrasses are
least dense adjacent to the dock or bulkhead; and

Are not constructed in areas specifically prohibited 33 for boat mooring under conditions of a permit issued in 34 accordance with ss. 403.91-403.929, 1984 Supplement to the 35 Florida Statutes 1983, as amended, or part IV of chapter 373, or 36 other form of authorization issued by a local government. 37

38 Structures that qualify for this exemption are relieved from any 39 requirement to obtain permission to use or occupy lands owned by 40 the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund 41 and, with the exception of those structures attached to a

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42 bulkhead on a parcel of land where there is no docking 43 structure, are may not be subject to any more stringent 44 permitting requirements, registration requirements, or other regulation by any local government. Structures associated with a 45 46 dock on a parcel of land pursuant to subparagraph 2. which comply 47 with this subsection create a presumption of compliance with any 48 requirement to minimize adverse environmental impacts. A local 49 government governments may require a permit either permitting or 50 one-time registration of floating vessel platforms to be 51 attached to a bulkhead on a parcel of land where there is no 52 other docking structure as necessary to ensure compliance with local ordinances, codes, or regulations. A local government 53 54 governments may require either permitting or one-time 55 registration of all other floating vessel platforms as necessary 56 to ensure compliance with the exemption criteria in this 57 section; to ensure compliance with local ordinances, codes, or 58 regulations relating to building or zoning, which are no more stringent than the exemption criteria in this section or address 59 60 subjects other than subjects addressed by the exemption criteria 61 in this section; and to ensure proper installation, maintenance, and precautionary or evacuation action following a tropical 62 storm or hurricane watch of a floating vessel platform or 63 64 floating boat lift that is proposed to be attached to a bulkhead 65 or parcel of land where there is no other docking structure. The department shall adopt a general permit by rule for the construction, 68 69 installation, operation, or maintenance of those floating vessel 70 platforms or floating boat lifts that do not qualify for the 71 exemption provided in this paragraph but do not cause 72 significant adverse impacts to occur individually or 73 cumulatively. The issuance of such general permit shall also 74 constitute permission to use or occupy lands owned by the Board 75 of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund. A local 76 government governments may not impose a more stringent regulation, permitting requirement, registration requirement, or 77 78 other regulation covered by such general permit. A local 79 government governments may require either permitting or one-time 80 registration of floating vessel platforms as necessary to ensure 81 compliance with the general permit in this section; to ensure 82 compliance with local ordinances, codes, or regulations relating 83 to building or zoning that are no more stringent than the general permit in this section; and to ensure proper 84 85 installation and maintenance of a floating vessel platform or 86 floating boat lift that is proposed to be attached to a bulkhead 87 or parcel of land where there is no other docking structure.
