29 (2) A mail service charge may be collected for each 30 registration certificate, registration certificate card, license plate, mobile home sticker, and validation sticker mailed by the 31 32 department or any tax collector. Each registration certificate, 33 registration certificate card, license plate, mobile home 34 sticker, and validation sticker shall be mailed by first-class mail unless otherwise requested by the applicant. The amount of 35 36 the mail service charge shall be the actual postage required, rounded to the nearest 5 cents, plus a 25-cent handling charge. 37 The mail service charge is in addition to the service charge 38 39 provided by s. 320.04.
