Between lines 453 and 454, insert:

7 Section 1. For the purpose of incorporating the amendment  
 8 made by this act to section 112.19, Florida Statutes, in a  
 9 reference thereto, paragraph (e) of subsection (4) of section  
 10 110.123, Florida Statutes, is reenacted to read:

11 110.123 State group insurance program.—

12 (4) PAYMENT OF PREMIUMS; CONTRIBUTION BY STATE; LIMITATION  
 13 ON ACTIONS TO PAY AND COLLECT PREMIUMS.—

14 (e) No state contribution for the cost of any part of the  
 15 premium shall be made for retirees or surviving spouses for any  
 16 type of coverage under the state group insurance program.

17 However, any state agency that employs a full-time law  
18 enforcement officer, correctional officer, or correctional  
19 probation officer who is killed or suffers catastrophic injury  
20 in the line of duty as provided in s. 112.19, or a full-time  
21 firefighter who is killed or suffers catastrophic injury in the  
22 line of duty as provided in s. 112.191, shall pay the entire  
23 premium of the state group health insurance plan selected for  
24 the employee's surviving spouse until remarried, and for each  
25 dependent child of the employee, subject to the conditions and  
26 limitations set forth in s. 112.19 or s. 112.191, as applicable.

27 Section 2. For the purpose of incorporating the amendment  
28 made by this act to section 112.19, Florida Statutes, in a  
29 reference thereto, subsection (1) of section 112.1912, Florida  
30 Statutes, is reenacted to read:

31 112.1912 First responders; death benefits for educational  
32 expenses.—

33 (1) As used in this section, the term "first responder"  
34 means:

35 (a) A law enforcement, correctional, or correctional  
36 probation officer as defined in s. 112.19(1) who is killed as  
37 provided in s. 112.19(2) on or after July 1, 2019;

38 (b) A firefighter as defined in s. 112.191(1) who is  
39 killed as provided in s. 112.191(2) on or after July 1, 2019; or
