Section 12. Subsection (1) of section 101.048, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

101.048 Provisional ballots.-

At all elections, a voter claiming to be properly 16 (1)17 registered in the state and eligible to vote at the precinct in 18 the election but whose eligibility cannot be determined, a 19 person whom an election official asserts is not eligible, 20 including a person whom an election official believes is not a 21 United States citizen but who provides proof of United States 22 citizenship in the form of a United States passport, certificate 23 of naturalization, or certificate of citizenship issued by the 24 United States Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services, 25 and other persons specified in the code shall be entitled to 26 vote a provisional ballot. Once voted, the provisional ballot 27 shall be placed in a secrecy envelope and thereafter sealed in a 28 provisional ballot envelope. The provisional ballot shall be 29 deposited in a ballot box. All provisional ballots shall remain sealed in their envelopes for return to the supervisor of 30 31 elections. The department shall prescribe the form of the 32 provisional ballot envelope. A person casting a provisional 33 ballot shall have the right to present written evidence 34 supporting his or her eligibility to vote to the supervisor of 35 elections by not later than 5 p.m. on the second day following 36 the election.
