18	the length of terms and stagger the election cycle for the
19	members of the Board of Trustees of the Barefoot Bay Recreation
20	District. If approved by the electors of the district voting in
21	a referendum election in November 2022, the members of the board
22	of trustees shall be elected as follows:
23	(1) In the election held in November 2023, the candidate
24	receiving the highest number of votes shall be elected to serve
25	a term of 3 years and the candidate receiving the second highest

27	(2) In the election held in November 2024, the candidates
28	receiving the highest and second highest number of votes shall

32	(3) In each subsequent election, candidates elected to
33	serve as members of the board of trustees shall each be elected
