Such data may 39 be based on internal financial reports that are certified to be complete and accurate by the chief financial officer of the 40 41 nursing home. However, the home office's actual financial 42 experience shall be its audited actual experience. This audited 43 actual experience must include the fiscal year-end balance 44 sheet, income statement, statement of cash flow, and statement 45 of retained earnings and must be submitted to the agency in 46 addition to the information filed in the uniform system of 47 financial reporting. The financial statements must tie to the 48 information submitted in the uniform system of financial 49 reporting, and a crosswalk must be submitted along with the audited financial statements. 50
