teacher's performance evaluation under s. 1012.34, based in part
on student performance as measured by a statewide, standardized
assessment or an Advanced Placement, Advanced International
Certificate of Education, or International Baccalaureate
examination.

e. Achieves a passing score on the Florida professionaleducation competency examination required by state board rule.

3. Meets the applicable requirements of paragraphs (2)(a)-30 (h) and completes a professional preparation and education 31 32 competence program approved by the department pursuant to 33 paragraph (8)(c) or an educator preparation institute approved 34 by the department pursuant to s. 1004.85. An applicant who 35 completes one of these programs and is rated highly effective as 36 determined by his or her performance evaluation under s. 1012.34 is not required to take or achieve a passing score on the 37 38 professional education competency examination in order to be awarded a professional certificate. 39

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40 (b) The department shall issue a temporary certificate to 41 any applicant who: 42 1. Completes the requirements outlined in paragraphs (2)(a)-(f) and completes the subject area content requirements 43 44 specified in state board rule or demonstrates mastery of subject 45 area knowledge pursuant to subsection (5) and holds an accredited degree or a degree approved by the Department of 46 Education at the level required for the subject area 47 specialization in state board rule; or 48 2. Documents 48 months of active-duty military service 49 50 with an honorable discharge or a medical separation; completes 51 the requirements outlined in paragraphs (2)(a), (b), and (d)-52 (f); completes the subject area content requirements specified 53 in state board rule or demonstrates mastery of subject area 54 knowledge pursuant to subsection (5); documents completion of 60 55 college credits with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 56 2.5 on a 4.0 scale, as provided by one or more accredited 57 institutions of higher learning or a nonaccredited institution 58 of higher learning identified by the Department of Education as 59 having a quality program resulting in a bachelor's degree or higher; and enrolls in a teacher preparation program approved 60 pursuant to s. 1004.04. 61 The department shall issue one nonrenewable 2-year 62 (C) temporary certificate and one nonrenewable 5-year professional 63
