 8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 10 Section 1. Subsection (8) of section 768.21, Florida
 11 Statutes, is amended to read:

12 768.21 Damages.—All potential beneficiaries of a recovery
 13 for wrongful death, including the decedent's estate, shall be
 14 identified in the complaint, and their relationships to the
 15 decedent shall be alleged. Damages may be awarded as follows:

16 (8) The damages specified in subsection (3) shall not be
 17 recoverable by adult children ~~and the damages specified in~~
 18 ~~subsection (4) shall not be recoverable by parents of an adult~~
 19 ~~child~~ with respect to claims for medical negligence as defined
 20 by s. 766.106(1).

21 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
