In developing the training, the institute shall consult 27 with law enforcement agencies, survivors of human trafficking, 28 industry representatives, tourism representatives, and other 29 interested parties. The institute also must conduct research to 30 determine the reduction in recidivism attributable to the 31 education of the harms of human trafficking for first-time 32 offenders.
