26 shall be protected or shielded from the use of a bolt cutter,
27 and the rod or cable shall be anchored in a manner that prevents
28 the removal of the firearm from the premises;

29 (b) Store the firearm in a locked fireproof safe or vault
30 in the licensee's business premises; or

31 (c) Store the firearm in a hardened, impact-resistant,
32 locked cabinet.

33 (2) A duly authorized agent or employee of the Department
34 of Agriculture and Consumer Services may inspect in a lawful
35 manner at all reasonable hours any business premises subject to
36 the requirements of this section.

37 (3) A violation of this section is a noncriminal
38 violation, punishable as provided in s. 775.083.
