Section 1. Subsections (1) and (2) of section 288.018, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

288.018 Regional Rural Development Grants Program.-

9 (1)(a) For the purposes of this section, the term "regional economic development organization" means an economic development organization located in or contracted to serve a rural area of opportunity, as defined in s. 288.0656(2)(d).

(b) The department shall establish a matching grant program to provide funding to regional economic development organizations for the purpose of building the professional capacity of those organizations. Building the professional 748055 - h0685-line18.docx

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17 capacity of a regional economic development organization includes hiring professional staff to develop, deliver, and 18 19 provide needed economic development professional services, including technical assistance, education and leadership 20 21 development, marketing, and project recruitment. Matching Grants 22 may also be used by a regional economic development organization to provide technical assistance to local governments, local 23 24 economic development organizations, and existing and prospective 25 businesses.

26 (c) A regional economic development organization may apply annually to the department for a matching grant. The department 27 is authorized to approve, on an annual basis, grants to such 28 29 regional economic development organizations. The maximum amount 30 an organization may receive in any year will be \$50,000, or 31 \$250,000 for any three regional economic development 32 organizations that serve an entire region of a rural area of 33 opportunity designated pursuant to s. 288.0656(7) if they are 34 recognized by the department as serving such a region.

35 (d) Grant funds received by a regional economic development 36 organization must be matched each year by nonstate resources in 37 an amount equal to 25 percent of the state contribution.

(1) There is created within the department the Rural Infrastructure Fund to facilitate the planning, preparing, and financing of infrastructure projects in rural communities which will encourage job creation, capital investment, and the strengthening and diversification of rural economies by promoting tourism, trade, and economic development.

78 (b) To facilitate access of rural communities and rural 79 areas of opportunity as defined by the Rural Economic 80 Development Initiative to infrastructure funding programs of the Federal Government, such as those offered by the United States 81 82 Department of Agriculture and the United States Department of 83 Commerce, and state programs, including those offered by Rural 84 Economic Development Initiative agencies, and to facilitate 85 local government or private infrastructure funding efforts, the 86 department may award grants for up to  $\frac{50}{75}$  percent of the total 87 infrastructure project cost, or up to 100 percent of the total 88 infrastructure project cost for a project located in a rural 89 community as defined in s. 288.0656(2)(e) or a rural area of
