Delete lines 23 - 166

Section 1. The Public Service Commission, in coordination with the Office of Energy within the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, the United States Department of Energy, and the Florida Solar Energy Center, shall provide a report to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by January 1, 2024, which identifies the fixed costs of serving customers who own or lease renewable generation



12 and the best practices and methods to reduce subsidization, if  
13 any. The report must also take into account the value of rooftop  
14 solar, including, but not limited to, the economic,  
15 environmental, resilience, efficiency, technical, and social  
16 aspects in ensuring that a public utility's general body of
