Subsection (7) of section 1012.56, Florida 17 Statutes, is amended to read: 1012.56 Educator certification requirements.-18 19 (7) TYPES AND TERMS OF CERTIFICATION.-(a) The Department of Education shall issue a professional 20 21 certificate for a period not to exceed 5 years to any applicant 22 who fulfills one of the following: 23 1. Meets all the applicable requirements outlined in 24 subsection (2). 25 2. For a professional certificate covering grades 6 through 26 12: 27 a. Meets the applicable requirements of paragraphs (2)(a)-(h). 28 29 b. Holds a master's or higher degree in the area of

31 c. Teaches a high school course in the subject of the 32 advanced degree.

d. Is rated highly effective as determined by the teacher's performance evaluation under s. 1012.34, based in part on student performance as measured by a statewide, standardized assessment or an Advanced Placement, Advanced International Certificate of Education, or International Baccalaureate examination.

e. Achieves a passing score on the Florida professionaleducation competency examination required by state board rule.

41 3. Meets the applicable requirements of paragraphs (2)(a)-42 (h) and completes a professional preparation and education competence program approved by the department pursuant to 43 44 paragraph (8)(c) or an educator preparation institute approved 45 by the department pursuant to s. 1004.85. An applicant who 46 completes one of these programs and is rated highly effective as 47 determined by his or her performance evaluation under s. 1012.34 48 is not required to take or achieve a passing score on the 49 professional education competency examination in order to be awarded a professional certificate. 50

51 (b) The department shall issue a temporary certificate to 52 any applicant who:

53 <u>1.</u> Completes the requirements outlined in paragraphs 54 (2)(a)-(f) and completes the subject area content requirements 55 specified in state board rule or demonstrates mastery of subject 56 area knowledge pursuant to subsection (5) and holds an 57 accredited degree or a degree approved by the Department of 58 Education at the level required for the subject area
