29	assigned, the primary contact shall remain assigned to the		
30	insured's claim until the insurer closes the claim or a party		
31	files suit on the claim. The designation of a primary contact		
32	shall not preclude other claims personnel, vendors, or		
33	professionals, including clerical staff members, and call center		
34	staff members, from working on portions of the insured's claim.
