12	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

14	Section 1. This act may be cited as the "Cassie Carli
15	Law."
16	Section 2. Subsection (10) is added to section 61.13,
17	Florida Statutes, to read:
18	61.13 Support of children; parenting and time-sharing;
19	powers of court
20	(10) In a proceeding under this chapter where a court
21	approves, grants, or modifies a parenting plan, the court must
22	consider whether it is in the best interests of the minor child
23	and the parties to require the parties to use a safe exchange
24	location as provided in s. 125.01(8) for the periodic exchange
25	of the minor child.

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27	Section 3. Subsection (8) is added to section 125.01,

29	125.01 Powers and duties				
30	(8)(a) The board of county commissioners in each county				
31	shall designate at least one parking lot at a sheriff's office,				
32	or substation thereof, as a safe exchange location at which				
33	parents who exercise time-sharing pursuant to a parenting plan				
34	or time-sharing schedule may meet to exchange custody of the				
35	minor child.				
36	(b) Each sheriff's office or substation parking lot				
37	designated as a safe exchange location must install a purple				
38	light on the parking lot premises to clearly identify the				
39	designated area as a safe exchange location. The safe exchange				
40	location must:				
41	1. Be accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.				
42	2. Provide adequate lighting and an external video				
43	surveillance system that records continuously, 24 hours a day, 7				
44	days a week.				
45	3. Provide at least one camera that is fixed on the				
46	parking lot; is able to record the area in the vicinity of the				
47	purple light during both day and night; records images that				
48	clearly and accurately display the time and date; and retains				
49	video surveillance recordings or images for at least 45 days.				
50	(c) A cause of action shall not lie against the county,				
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51	the sheriff, a county commissioner, a law enforcement officer,
52	or an employee of the designated safe exchange location based on
53	any incident arising out of a meeting at a safe exchange
54	location pursuant to this subsection.
55	Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.

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
