A bill to be entitled

An act relating to carbon sequestration; requiring the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services to conduct a study on carbon sequestration activities and programs; providing study requirements; requiring the department to submit a report to the Legislature by a specified date; providing an appropriation; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. (1) The Department of Agriculture and Consumer

 Services shall conduct a study on carbon sequestration

 activities and programs. At a minimum, the study must include:
- (a) A comprehensive list of existing state agency carbon sequestration activities and programs available to agricultural producers in the state.
- (b) Recommendations for a state level exchange program to assist agricultural producers in participating in carbon sequestration activities.
- (c) Legislative recommendations for the creation of a carbon sequestration program.
- (2) By October 1, 2023, the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services shall submit a report on the results of the study to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the
