16 (h) (g) An amusement ride powered so as to be capable of 17 exceeding its maximum safe operating speed must be provided with 18 a maximum-speed-limiting device.

19 <u>(i)(h)</u> The interior and exterior parts of all patron-20 carrying amusement rides with which a patron may come in contact 21 must be smooth and rounded and free from sharp, rough, or 22 splintered edges and corners, and from projecting studs, bolts, 23 and screws or other projections that might cause injury.

24 <u>(j)(i)</u> Signs that advise or warn patrons of age 25 restrictions, size restrictions, health restrictions, weight 26 limitations, or any other special consideration or use 27 restrictions, or lack thereof, required or recommended for the 28 amusement ride by the manufacturer must be prominently displayed 29 at the patron entrance of each amusement ride.
