(10) A health maintenance organization may not retroactively deny a claim because of subscriber ineligibility at any time, except a health maintenance organization may retroactively deny a claim for subscriber ineligibility within 1 year after the date of payment of the claim if the provider was convicted of fraud pursuant to s. 817.234. This subsection applies to contracts entered into or renewed on or after January 1, 2024 more than 1 year after the date of payment of the claim. Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
