Section 1. Subsection (9) is added to section 595.405, Florida Statutes, to read:

595.405 School nutrition program requirements.-

(9) Upon the request of a student who is eligible for free or reduced-price meals or snacks under the National School Lunch Program or any other program, or upon the request of his or her parent or guardian, a school district must provide the student with a plant-based, kosher, or halal meal or snack that complies with federal nutrition mandates at the same cost to the student as a non-plant-based, non-kosher, or non-halal meal or snack. The request by such student or his or her parent or guardian for an alternative meal or snack may be made at the beginning of each semester. Each school district must publish information about meal and snack alternatives on its website.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
